

How to complete this incident diary

In order for us to deal effectively with any anti social behaviour (ASB) it is essential to have accurate, detailed information about what is taking place, even if it does not result in legal action being taken. It is important that this incident diary is a true reflection of what you saw and/or heard. Please use as much space as you need on the diary and continue on another sheet if necessary.

Date and time of incident

It is important that the correct date and time of the incident are recorded. Please also tell us how long the incident lasted.

Details of incident, including who did it and where it happened

Details of the incident should be entered here, including who was involved. If you don't know names, describe them and give any other information about them, ie: their address. Say as much as you can about the location of the incident.

Were there any witnesses?

Please give witnesses names and contact details if you can. It helps to have information from as many sources as possible.

Was the incident reported? If so, when, and to whom?

If an incident was reported please say who it was reported to and how you did this, ie: face to face or by phone. Please give as much information as you can, including Police reference numbers if you have them.

How did the incident affect you?

It is important to know how this incident has affected you or your family. For example, did you feel frightened, alarmed, distressed? Have you lost sleep?

How will this information be used?

Your details or the information you provide will not be disclosed to anyone without your permission.

Do not hang on to your completed diaries - send them back.
